The 2010 Youth Art Exhibit at the Port

Plan now to enter your work in ACYA's annual Youth Art Exhibit at the Port! This special event takes place in coordination with the Anacortes Arts Festival, August 6-8. Any original artwork you have created at school or elsewhere since August 2009 is eligible. You may submit work in any of the following media: drawing, painting, photography, sculpture, ceramics, collage, mixed-media, metal, original computer art (no clip art!), basketry, and fiber arts. Due to space constraints, each artist is limited to no more than two entries.

Art intake day will be July 25 from 1:00 pm – 3:00 pm at the Anacortes Port Warehouse. Please complete the entry form on the back of this flyer and bring it with your artwork to the Port on that day. To protect your work, all two-dimensional art must be matted or backed, and shrink-wrapped or framed. Artwork with glass must have a traditional frame around the edges. Small sculpture pieces/parts need to be attached firmly to a base. Custom matting and framing is available through Scott Milo Gallery; plan ahead to ensure that there is adequate time to prepare your work!

The exhibit continues during the Arts Festival weekend, August 6 - 8. Artwork **must** be picked up after the festival closes, at 5:00 p.m. on August 8.
